

**Note:** This overview uses iOS screen images, but it applies to both iOS and Android. Android users may find small differences in look and feel, but the key functions are identical.

## Login

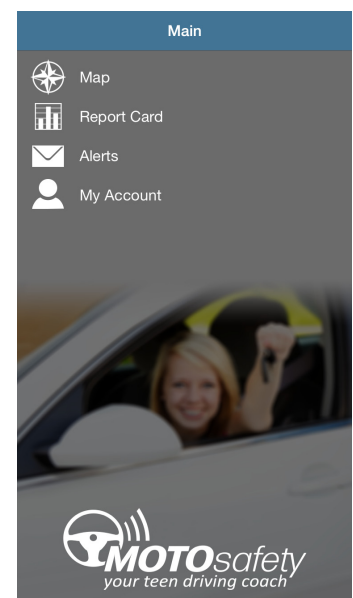
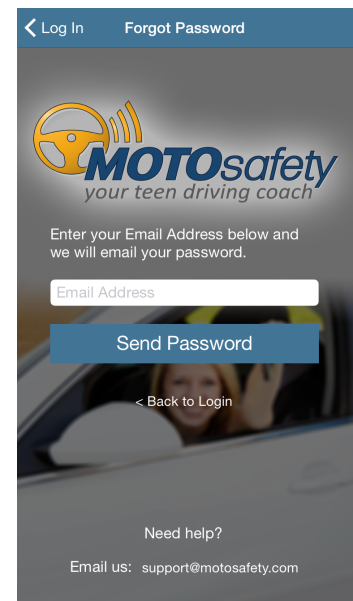
When you first launch the application, you will be presented with the login screen. You can log in with the same email address and password you use to log in to the web-based portal.

## Forgot Your Password

If you've forgotten your password, you can use the Forgot Your Password screen to have the system send you a copy of your password. After your first login, the system will always automatically log you in unless you logout.

## Main Menu

After you log in, you will be on the Main Menu screen that you can use to access the different areas of the App.



## Devices Screen

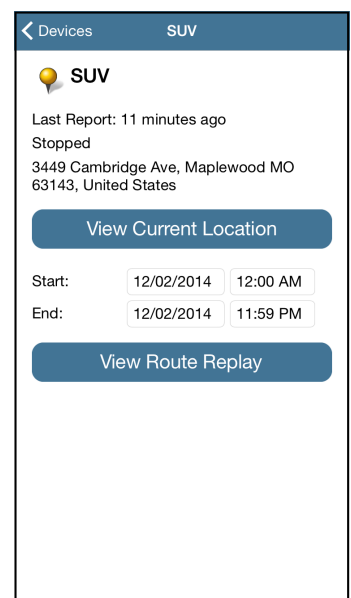
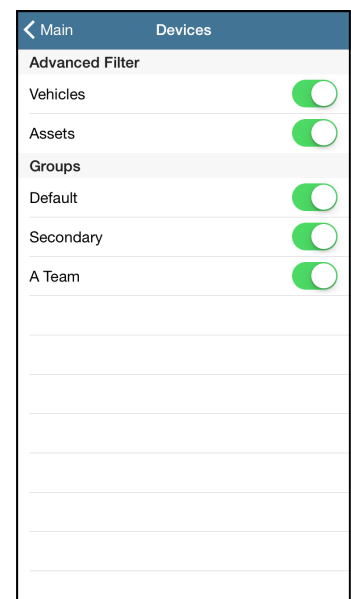
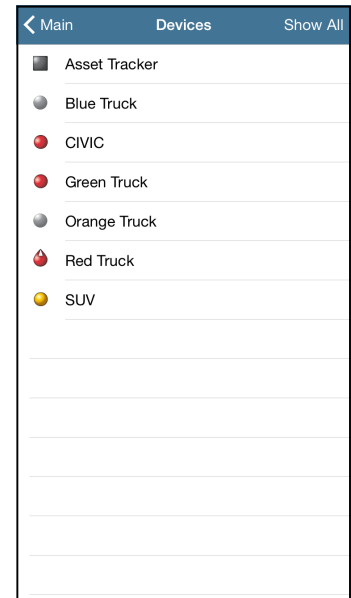
If you select Map from the Main Menu, you will be taken to a list of all your Vehicles. You can view any Vehicle on the map by clicking it. If you click Show All in the upper-right hand corner, all your vehicles will be displayed on the map simultaneously.

## Device List Filters

If you slide the Devices Screen from the right-hand side of the screen, you will reveal the Advanced Filters. This allows you to filter your Devices list for Vehicles, Assets or by Groups (if applicable). Once you set these filters, the App will remember your settings until you update them.

## Vehicle Detail

After clicking on a Vehicle, you will be able to view detailed information on the vehicle's current location and status. You also have the option to View the Vehicle on the map or to View Route Replay.



## Making Selections

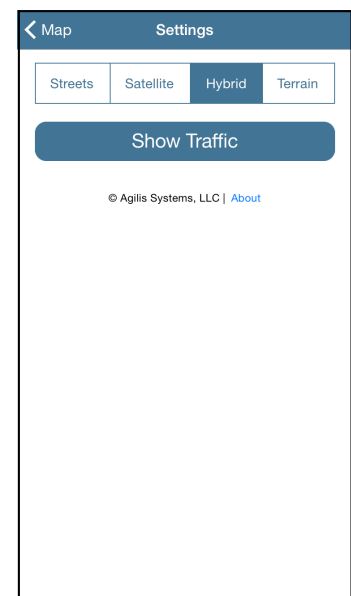
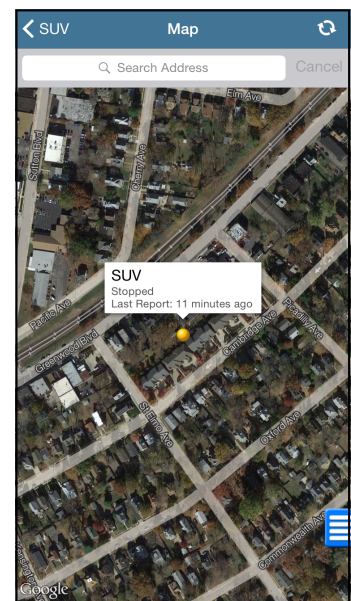
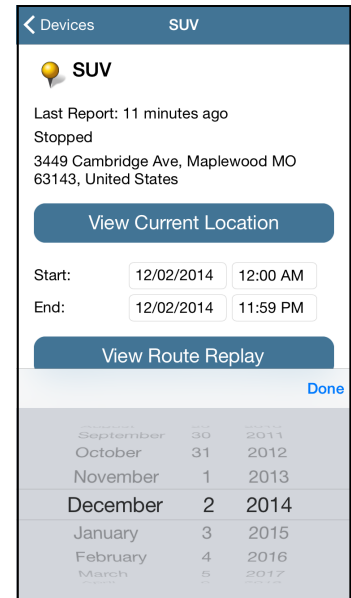
Clicking on a field such as the date field in the Route Replay settings will pop-up a date picker or other types of data pickers allowing you to make your selections.

## Map View

If you click View Current Location, the map will load and show you visually the vehicle's current location. You can scroll around the map using your finger and zoom in and out by pinching the screen with two fingers. In the upper-right hand corner of the screen is a refresh button that will update the map with the latest information. Also note the blue menu button at the bottom right.

## Map Settings

Clicking the blue menu button will reveal the Map Settings. Here you can select different views including Streets, Satellite, Hybrid and Terrain. You can also toggle Traffic off and on.





## Alerts



From the Main Menu, if you select Alerts you can review Alerts for your Vehicles. You can view Alerts for All Vehicles or individual Vehicles. You can also view all Alert types or individual Alert types. Alert searches are limited to no more than one week's worth of time per search.

## Alert Details

Once you search for Alerts, you go to a screen that shows all Alerts for the period. The Alerts icons on the left-hand side of the screen indicate the Alert type, and you get details on each Alert. Clicking Show on Map will allow you to view visually on the map the location of any Alert.


## Report Card

From the Main Menu, if you select Report Card, you are taken to the Report Card for your Vehicles. You can select the Vehicle you want to review and the month and year.

## Report Card Details


Once you select the Device and time frame, you will get the Report Card results for your vehicle. You get summary data for the month, along with detailed daily results for each day of the month.
